Parking Sticker F.A.Q's – Dec 2019

- Do StoneyBrook or Cambridge residents need to register for stickers?
 - No these residents do not need a sticker; however, if a StoneyBrook or Cambridge resident is park from the hours of 10p.m. -5 a.m. in common area they will need to use a visitor's parking permit or have a parking sticker.
- What if I have a significant other/care taker who stays overnight most of the week but does not live with me, can they get a parking sticker?
 - The significant other or care taker will not be able to register for a parking sticker and will therefore have to use a guest parking permit either each night or for the duration of their stay.
- Is there an expiration date on the guest parking permits?
 - No, there will not be an expiration date added to the guest parking permits. If your guest is staying for an extended time they are allowed to write the dates of their stay on one guest permit; however, to ensure that this does not get abused, Security will be monitoring the guest parking permits and vehicles using them.
- Where can we get more guest parking permits if we run out?
 - The HUA Office and Security Office will have extra guest permits if you need more. We will also be making it available online at the HeatherRidge website for you to print them at home if you have a printer.
- How do I prove proof of residency if I am a resident of another state and live in HeatherRidge part of the year?
 - If your driver's license is from another state or your vehicle is registered in a different state we will accept a copy of the latest utility bill; electric, water, telephone land/cell, cable or gas for proof of residency.
- Where should the sticker be placed in the cars?
 - The sticker should be placed on the rear window on the driver's side.
- If I live in the condos and have a space in the garage where I park do I need to get a sticker?
 - Yes, the stickers are going to help Security identify owners by the sticker number should there ever be a problem with the car or space the car is parked in. It is also a good idea in case the resident leaves their car parked in a common area over night by mistake.
